## The 4th South Asia Rally Report

The 4th South Asia Rally took place in our shores on the 19th March 2017. It was a one day event which was held at the Vertical Hotel & Nexus Convention Centre in Bangsar South City, Kuala Lumpur.

The rally saw participants from almost all South Asia countries with Innerwheel clubs like India, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Pakistan,



Nepal, Singapore & host country Malaysia. Participants who attended the rally totalled 545 while we had over 600 people who attended the banquet dinner on the same night.

The ballroom was filled with excited participants from all over South Asia and the atmosphere was very festive. The highlight of the morning was the keynote speaker Dr Suresh Govind with his 'Women- the most powerful influence in the world' who completely floored the five hundred odd ladies and had them in stitches.
