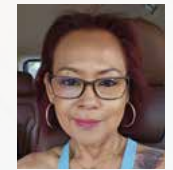

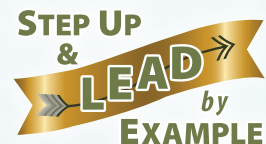

Operational Excellence & Leadership Development

At the start of my term, recognising our evolving practices, Past IIW Board Director Jessie Wang, a member of the Advisory Council, proposed a revision to the District and Club Guidelines. We promptly undertook this effort, introducing updates that reflect modern administrative standards, streamline formatting for clarity, and offer practical guidance. I am confident this guide will remain an indispensable resource for future leaders, ensuring adherence to our Constitution with integrity and accountability.

Motivated by our call to action, an interactive training workshop for club officers was initiated and conducted on 27 September 2025, following the 45th Annual General Meeting. This aligned with International Inner Wheel’s mandatory requirement for the training of club officers. I hope these workshops continue, as they provide a vital platform for learning and growth to develop confident, capable future leaders.

Unity in Service and Global Friendship

Over the past year, I have seen this leadership spirit come alive through the women of District 330—not just in major initiatives, but through quiet, consistent acts of compassion for the less fortunate, the elderly, women, and children. Clubs also extended their support for homes, hospitals and schools. I have chosen not to name individual clubs because each has served with dedication and heart – whether seen or unseen, spoken or quietly carried out. What matters most is the impact of your service and the lives you have touched, not the recognition.

Our journey proved that leadership belongs to people, not positions. It is reflected in our choices, our values, and the way we support one another. What stood out most was not just what we achieved, but how we achieved it. There was a spirit of unity, a willingness to collaborate, and a genuine desire to serve with purpose. We did not wait for change—we became it.

In the spirit of international understanding, we warmly welcomed visiting Inner Wheel sisters from overseas and visited clubs abroad, fostering global goodwill, exchanging ideas, and building lasting friendships.

Key Milestones & Collaborative Impact

Our collective impact was powerfully demonstrated through several key events this year:

- **Orange the World Walkathon 2025 (30 November 2025):** Part of the UN Women global campaign to end violence against women, this initiative brought members, families, and friends across Malaysia together. Initiated by the IWC of Kuala Lumpur and supported by the IWC of Parklands alongside Districts 330 and 331, we were officially recognised in the Malaysia Book of Records for the largest gathering in support of this cause.
- **World Inner Wheel Day (January):** Our northern clubs, organized by the IWC of Pearl of the Orient, celebrated by generously donating 15 dialysis chairs to Seberang Jaya Hospital—a testament to what we can achieve hand in hand.
- **International Women's Day (8 March):** Though we could not gather in fellowship to continue the Legacy 2025 spirit, we honoured 15 outstanding women nominated by their clubs. They were recognized with Certificates of Appreciation and featured on our District website for their quiet strength and dedication.

Foundations for the Future

Visiting all 20 clubs in District 330 was a deeply fulfilling highlight of my tenure. These visits provided valuable opportunities to connect, listen, and reinforce the four focus areas I set for our term:

- **Strengthening membership and fostering growth** to bring in fresh energy.
- **Deepening friendships and unity** as the core of Inner Wheel.
- **Promoting good governance and accountability** to sustain strong clubs.
- **Providing quality training** to secure our organization's future.

Through improved communication, revisiting our Constitution, and embracing forward-thinking approaches, we have strengthened our District with clarity and resilience.

Yet, beyond all plans, it is the human connections—the shared laughter and sincere conversations—that I will cherish most. 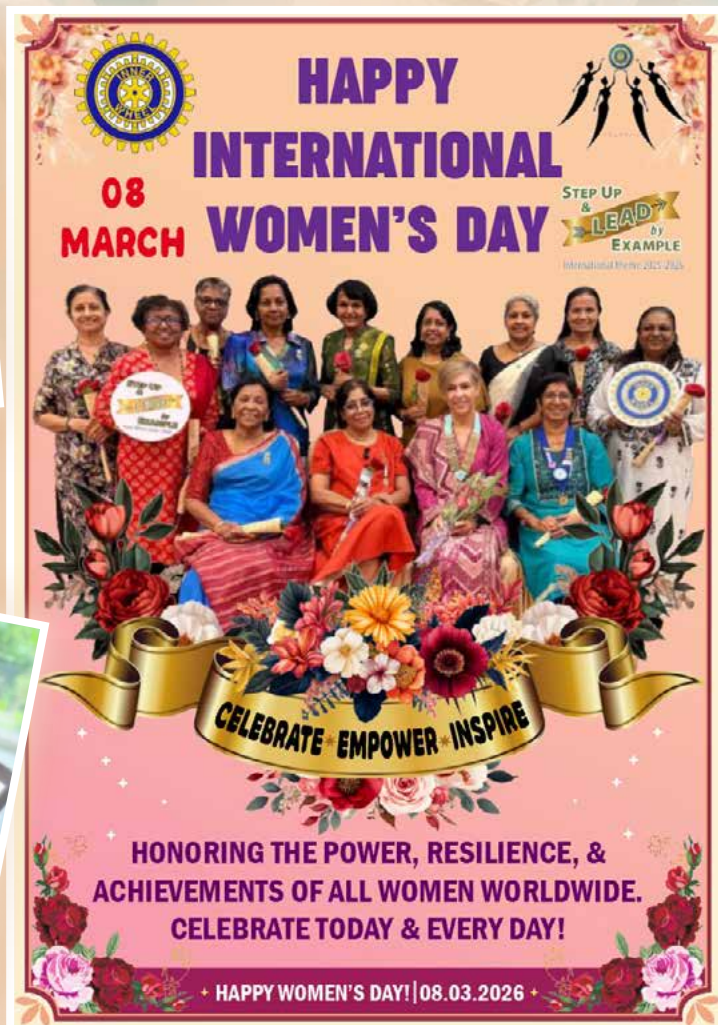

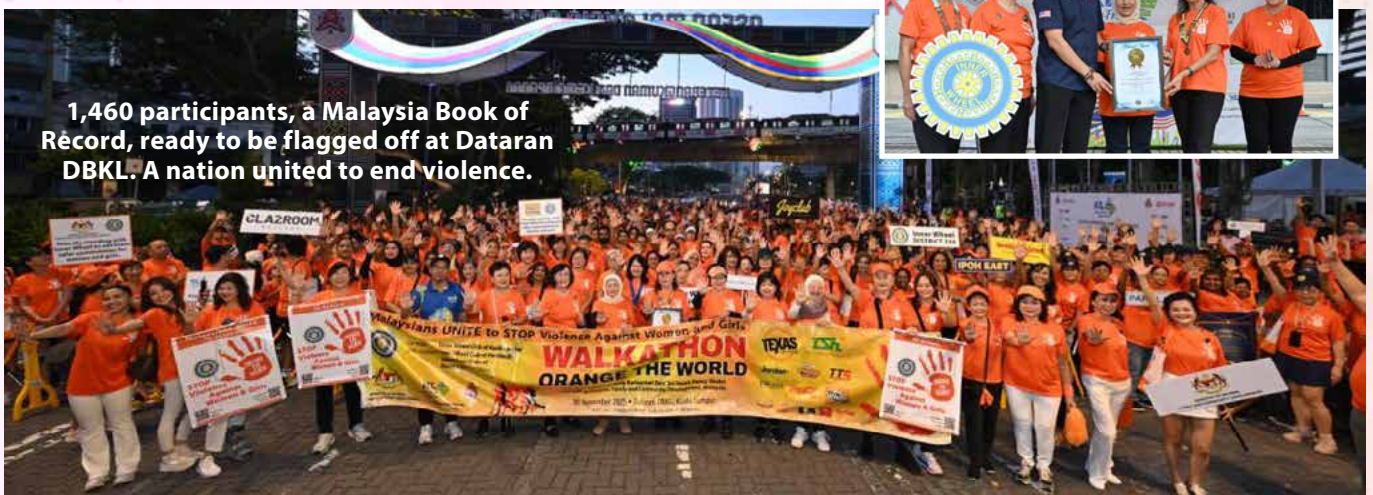
